The film series is Bay County Audubon Society's fundraiser to support its community citizen-science and outreach program. Next year will be the 45th year that Bay County Audubon has brought travel/adventure films to the local community.

The Audubon Society's film series will feature four nature/travel films narrated in person by the internationally acclaimed cinematographers. The 2014 series will feature Stan Walsh's "Italian Lakes Adventure," Tom Sterling's "The Gift of the White Moose and Florida's Alien Wildlife," John Holod's "Eastern Canada Adventure," and Bob DeLoss's "Pacific Coast, Top to Bottom."
