Over the past 16 years, The St. Joe Community Foundation has supported many area nonprofits to help feed the hungry, tend to community members that are sick or injured, provide assistance to help shelter those who may have lost their way in life, and even fund a toy drive or two. One of those organizations that the Foundation continues to support is The Salvation Army, whose mission is providing hope, compassion, strength and faith.

The Foundation's support to The Salvation Army was enhanced when Hurricane Katrina hit the Northwest Florida area. Funding to the Army was one of the larger investments the Foundation granted as The Salvation Army team of experts provided disaster relief for hurricane victims in Bay, Gulf, Franklin and Walton Counties that year. The Salvation Army was instrumental in helping people who were struggling with flooding in their



communities, as well as assisting those in need of food, clothing, shelter and faith.

The following year, The Salvation Army was granted funding to complete the purchase of a mobile response unit, or canteen truck, to bring hot meals to those in disaster areas since flooding and other hurricanes had continued to impact Northwest Florida. The new canteen truck has been used several times in Bay and surrounding areas to serve

the people and first-responders in times of severe weather and power failures, major fires and flooding.

The Salvation Army also provides for those in need of hope. Their Domestic Violence and Rape Crisis Programs assist women and children in local communities who need the hope and strength of the Salvation Army to overcome their hopelessness and despair. The Foundation has provided funding for this program that provides a safe haven, counseling and meals to those fleeing abusive conditions and seeking guidance toward safety and stability in their lives.
