

The Destin Wine Auction Foundation unveils its biggest auction lot

- **PANAMA CITY BEACH, Fla. (WJHG/WECP)** - The Destin Charity Wine Auction Foundation has raised over \$13 million for children. They have auctioned vacations, wines, and homes before. They have never auctioned off a car, until Wednesday. The foundation had a unveiling **event** at the Watersound Cafe and they unveiled the largest lot in the history of their foundation, a 2010 Tesla Roadster. There has only ever been 2,400 models made.



The President of the foundation, John Russell, is impressed that every year the auction continues to raise more money.

"Last year we donated \$2,260,000. So, of course, everyone is looking at us and asking us if we are going to do \$3 million this year. But getting this great car donated by the St. Joe Community Foundation as an auction lot is going to give us a good, uh no pun intended, jump start on that path," said Russell.

The Tesla will be up for auction on April 29th and the Wine Festival is April 28th-30th.
